

The contribution in the project development by Pomeranian Equestrian Federation, consisted in: participation in workshops, videoconferences organized by project partners and discussions during the meetings. On the other hand, there was a process of disseminating information about the project among stables-members of the federation and consistent improvement of the internal document reflecting the current vision of equestrian tourism. Meetings were organized, consultations in various circumstances, such as horse competitions or workshops, as well as discussions around document placed on the Federation's website available to everyone

The following topics were discussed during the consultations

Rallies for people with lower limb dysfunction. Stables interested in serving this type of tourist should plan appropriate equipment such as invasions, special toilets, elevators and properly equipped rooms.

Certification of horses for this tourism and training of instructors will be required.

Subsidies from the National Health Service

Lessons for school children should considered as integral element of school program and be co-financed by local authorities

Closer cooperation between participating stables, schools and local authorities is recommende

In the first stage of project development for equestrian tourism trails, existing connections between stables should be used and then step by step develop a larger network of connections to attractive tourist destinations seats

Maintenance of horse roads should be the responsibility of the stables, not the forests authority

Talks with state forestry authorities to reach agreement on the trials network are the most important and should take place in the first place

Due to its proximity to the sea, at least two locations should be considered, where the hub will be an intersection of horse, bicycle, walking paths near the marina;

The longest horse/carriage rally should be three days

Developing a strategy for the horse tourism in Pomerania region

Katarzyna Zdrojewska and Jarosław Szerszenowicz, Arabian Horse Stable in Przywidz presented their vision of the strategy's objectives and the path of its implementation.

The strategy document is available for the participating stables. Also, during consultation meetings, the draft strategy document was presented and discussed. Many received comments and remarks allow to improve the subsequent versions of the document. The final version was posted on the website of the Pomeranian Equestrian Federation, where it is available to all interested parties. The power point version will also be used during consultations planned for the upcoming fall.
